format & rules

FORMAT: Four person scramble tournament.

TEAM COMPETITIONS:

Lowest 18 Hole Score - Lowest total team score for all 18 holes

Team Skins - Lowest team score on a hole, pars or better, no ties. *(optional buy-in at registration)*

INDIVIDUAL SKILLS CONTESTS ARE LOCATED ON THE FOLLOWING HOLES:

Closest to the Pin - all Par 3's - Men and Ladies

Longest Drive - Hole # 7 - Ladies; Hole #18 Men

Longest Putt Made - Hole #18 – Combined Men and Ladies

Putting Contest - Putting Green

Chipping Contest - Front Lawn area

GOLF ETIQUETTE:

1. Please smooth all marks made in sand bunkers, replace divots, and repair ball marks on greens.
2. No more than 1-2 minutes looking for a lost ball.
3. Leave the putting green as soon as you have holed out.
4. Do not play until the players in front of you are out of range.
5. Balls may be cleaned on the green, and ball marks repaired prior to putting. Please observe all local course rules.
6. Enjoy the day and your fellowship with other golfers!

GOLF SCRAMBLE RULES:

1. Each team gets 4 Mulligans. The team decides if they want to use a mulligan on a specific hole, but must decide if they want to use the mulligan before they take their next shot on the hole. The team can select which team member takes the extra shot. Mulligans can be used on a Tee shot, a Fairway shot, or a putt. A mulligan cannot win a CTP, Longest Drive, or Longest Putt.
2. A scramble means that all team members tee off on each hole and decide which tee shot they like the best and mark the spot with a tee or ball marker.
3. The other team members pick up their balls and place them within one club length (no closer to the hole) of the marked spot. Each team member hits their next shot from the chosen spot of the prior shot
4. If the ball you choose to play is in a hazard (sand, water, etc.), the rough, or out of bounds, you cannot drop the ball outside of the hazard or rough even if relief is within one club length away.
5. This procedure is followed on every shot for the remainder of the hole, including putts. The ball should be marked on the putting green also.

6. Putts need to be made within 3 inches of the marked spot (no closer to the hole). The first ball to go in the hole is counted for the team score. When putting, once any ball is holed out, no further strokes count. The team is cautioned not to make “tap-in” putts until all team members have had the opportunity to attempt the team’s original putt.
7. If your hole score is higher than a bogie, i.e. double bogie or 2 over par, pick up and record a double bogie (2 over par).
8. Men tee off from the white tees, men over 70 years old, from the silver tees, and women from the silver tees.
9. Threesomes are permitted to rotate a fourth shot for each hole. Rotation is set on 1st, 2nd, and 3rd holes played and repeated for the rest of the round. The rotated shot is not eligible to win a CTP, Longest Drive, or Longest Putt.
10. In the case of a tie, staff will compare the score card of the teams that have tied starting with the hole with the highest handicap moving to the hole with the lowest handicap, continuing until one team has the lowest score on a hole.
11. Turn your scorecard into the Club House Pro Shop following your round.

These rules are subject to change/updating prior to the start of the tournament.
